

## Set JAVA\_HOME IN CENTOS 7

- Follow the listed steps to set JAVA\_HOME in CentOS 7

Log in to your server as root user.

To check your installed java version :

```
java -version
```

Set JAVA\_Home Environment variable on basis of java version. For jdk-1.8.0-openjdk .

```
export JAVA_HOME=/usr/java/jdk.1.8.0_60
```

Set JAVA\_Home Environment variable on basis of java version.

```
export PATH=$PATH:$JAVA_HOME
```

*It is the recommended add the following command to /etc/profile.d/.It is the recommended place to add customizations to the system profile.*

```
export JRE_HOME=/usr/java/jdk1.8.0_60/jre  
export PATH=$PATH:$JRE_HOME/bin
```

```
export JAVA_HOME=/usr/java/jdk1.8.0_60  
export JAVA_PATH=$JAVA_HOME
```

```
export PATH=$PATH:$JAVA_HOME/bin
```
